



Behavior Support Plan/HRC Due Process in Plain Language

1. **Notification:** You must be told if a Behavior Plan is being made about you.



2. **Participation:** You have the right to participate in your Behavior Support Plan development.



3. **Consent:** You can say **YES**, you agree to the Behavior Support Plan,
or
You can say **NO**, you do not agree to the Behavior Support Plan.



4. **Reconsider:** You can change your mind regarding your decision about the Behavior Support Plan at any time. You can let your Behavior Specialists, a staff member, your Care Manager, or anyone know you have changed your mind.



5. **HRC:** You can participate in the meeting that will discuss your plan.
